VIN = vehicle identity number


The VIN on your car is like its fingerprint.

No 2 cars have the same VIN no.

When do you need your VIN

- ✓ When registering your car.
- ✓ When insuring your car.
- ✓ When checking recalls, registrations, thefts, warranty claims and insurance cover.
- ✓ When you do your self-inspection on our self-service portal or go for an inspection at 1 of our approved inspection centres (remember no inspection = no cover.)

Where can you find it



- 1 Stand in front of your car. Look at the bottom right-hand side of the windscreen, the VIN will appear there.
- 2 On the inside (where the door hatches) of the driver's door.
- 3 Your car's service booklet.
- 4 On your car's licence disc.
